MURI-99 REVIEW

There will be a review of the new Innovative Microwave Vacuum Electronics MURI program sponsored by DDR&E held in conjunction with the IEEE International Vacuum Electronics Conference in Monterey (<http://www.ewh.ieee.org/soc/eds/ivec/>). The one-day review will take place on May 1, 2000, in the Monterey Conference Center, Colton Room. Presenters will be representatives of participating universities in MURI99 (UC Davis, Maryland, Michigan, MIT, Stanford, and Wisconsin), as well as invited speakers from government laboratories including AFRL, NRL, and NASA/ERC. Research reports will deal predominantly with basic research and predicted requirements aimed at supporting critical DoD needs for advanced communication, ECM, surveillance, and other electronic systems which require affordable, light weight and reliable sources of high levels of microwaves and millimeter waves. It is expected that representatives from industry (including Small Business), the DoD, and the DoE will be in attendance. The meeting will bring together microwave tube researchers and decision-makers from both the scientific and military electronics communities.
